§ With regard to construction at the Osell property on Eldridge Road, the Building Inspector will not issue a permit without further discussing the matter with town council. This issue surrounds road discontinuance. Fitz-Gibbons wants more information on what rulings were made for Eldridge Road, and what acreage is large enough for a back lot. The road was discontinued in 1810, but in 1989 the Selectboard stated that the road was still a town road from 116 up to the "first residence". Tom searched the Registry of Deeds and found that Hickory Ridge Road ends at Manwells house but that is a not clear definition.
