Bob presented a proposal for work on Bardwell’s Ferry Road from SVE Associates Engineering in Greenfield for \$33,000.00.

Christina signed an authorization to allow Bob to apply for a fire equipment grant through the Dept. of Public Safety.

Bob recommended that we request bids for mowing for this year. This was partially due to a request from Bear River Landscaping for an increase in fees due to the rise in gasoline prices.

Bob also asked the Board for their permission to request bids for new trucks approved by town meeting.
