7:30 Bid opening – Bardwell's Ferry Road engineering

8:30 Bob Baker – Various

Bob noted that the Highway Department account budgets are or will be overdrawn at the end of the fiscal year mostly due to storm damage costs from an April storm. He will get a reimbursement of 75% the FEMA and 25% from MEMA. However there may be a cost overrun on fuel and electricity. Bob said he would hold off on any stone and oil projects until the budget is reviewed after July 1st. It was also noted that the vehicle maintenance accounts were also overdrawn for both the Highway and Fire Departments.

9:00 Mike Kurkulonis - Drainage on Roaring Brook Road

There was a discussion regarding drainage from Roy Cohen's property. The drainage ditch was previously dug out and replaced with large riprap. Roy Requested a diagonal pipe replaced with a larger pipe located lower than the existing pipe. Both pipes would serve during severe storms. The local homeowners would consider having the road paved to reduce erosion and would be willing to stone and oil their driveway if the town paved the road. It was agreed that the town apply a large riprap to the ends of a new pipe. The Board asked Tom to request a letter from Roy Cohen that states what he is asking for and an easement before the town will process.
